

City of Bangor Cemetery Committee Meeting Minutes August 28, 2023

- 1. *Call To Order:* Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairperson Lynne Farmer.
- 2. **Pledge of Allegiance:** Pledge begun by Bob Emmert. Recited by all present.
- 3 Roll Call: Present: Bob Emmert, Lynne Farmer, David Pobuda, Dillon Rock, John Saylor, and William Murphy Jr. Also present Interim City Manager Justin Weber. Absent: Fred Hicks.
- 4. **Approval of the Agenda:** Motion by Bob Emmert. Support by Jr. Murphy to approve the agenda with the addition of New Business #7 e resignation of Kathy Sparks. Motion Carried.
- 5. Approval of the July 24, 2023 minutes: Motion by John Saylor to approve the July 24, 2023 Minutes as presented. Support by Bob Emmert. Motion Carried.

6. Old Business:

- a. Financial report. It was pointed out that we gained \$1,719.81 from delinquent taxes being paid. Yearly balance of \$14,965.91 remains.
- b. Update on the Cemetery Booklet. Lynne reported that she has been corresponding with Tiana at Pat's Pronto Prints on the booklet.
- c. Junipers on the Cemetery hill. Lynne reported that she was informed that another person not Bryce Saylor was asked to plant the junipers by the outgoing City Manager. Also that a work order was sent to the DPW Department for soaker hoses and for the junipers to be watered. Also Bryce Saylor will replant them in the correct spot along the hillside in the fall for no charge to the Cemetery Board.

7. New Business:

- a. Discussion of the pole if we proceed with the camera at the cemetery. David Pobuda is checking with his boss and will need the dimensions and the bracket dimensions for the camera.
- b. Cemetery Clean Up will be September 23rd from 10:00 until 2:00. Discussion on the 4 young men that need community service helping. They will be partnered with another adult.
- c. Bryce Saylor's quote for repairs to the cannon base presented. David Pobuda moved that we get a second quote for the work. Supported by Dillon Rock. Dillon has someone he will contact for the 2nd quote. Will be voted on at the next meeting. Motion Carried.
- d. Dan and Laura Stout's son Cody's burial. There was a discussion that Dan and Laura were never told their son was being buried in the Potter's field. They were told they could purchase lots in that field for \$100.00 each by the outgoing City Manager. When it was brought to the Cemetery Sexton's attention it was decided they would buy 2 lots in the new cemetery section and the Cemetery Committee would discuss donating a lot for their son to be reburied. We will have to have our City Attorney help us get the necessary paperwork from the court to make that happen. Discussion followed. John Saylor finally made the motion that we give the Stout's a plot next to theirs for their son. Jr. Murphy Supported. *Roll Call Vote:* Ayes: Bob Emmert, Lynne Farmer, Jr Murphy, David Pobuda, Dillon Rock, John Saylor and Justin Weber. Nays: None. Absent: Fred Hicks. Motion Carried.
- e. Resignation of Kathy Sparks effectiveAugust 7, 2023. Motion by Bob Emmert to accept Kathy Sparks resignation effective August 7, 2023. Support by Jr. Murphy. Motion Carried.

- b. Sexton and DPW Report: Patty Watkins will be buried tomorrow.
- c. Cemetery Committee Comments: David Pobuda: We had a great meeting and great discussion. John Saylor: No comment. Justin Weber: Asked why there was no Sexton or DPW Report? Lynne stated that John Saylor used to give that report and until things are settled in the DPW we don't have anyone to report. Bob Emmert: Asked how we were coming along on the copying of Cemetery Records? Discussion to fill in new members on the old cemetery books we had up stairs of City Hall. Dillon Rock: Dillon asked if he might have the lot numbers for the Stout burials and if there were any Veteran's in those old books, especially 1910? Lynne said,

she would ask Amanda Karr. Jr.: No Comment. Lynne: Thanked everyone on the committee for their hard work and stated how much she appreciates all of the committee members.

9. Adjourn the Meeting: Motion by Jr. Murphy to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 PM. Support by Dillon Rock. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:10 PM.
