VOTING METHOD #1 ABSENTEE

Any registered voter can vote with an absentee ballot. There is no requirement to provide an excuse.

There are 2 steps to this process:

1) Submit a ballot application

(unless you have previously submitted a permanent ballot application)

2) Return your voted ballot

by mail or absentee ballot drop box (locations listed on front of brochure)

OFFICE BEFORE 8:00 PM ON ELECTION DAY
